Join us on Thursday, August 24 at Colonial Café in St. Charles for an informative meeting about Altrusa. Yearbooks will be ready for distribution at this meeting. If you are unable to attend, they will be mailed to you (or sent with a family member or friend).

Our speaker for the meeting is our own Dana Vierck. Her topic is going to be the Altrusa International Foundation—how it impacts the local clubs, how it spends its money and what we can do to help it provide more service to our world. Dana just completed two years as Grants Chair on the Foundation. Her term ended at Convention in July.

It should be noted that Fox Valley Altrusa won recognition as the club that contributed the most to the International Foundation per capita. We also won an award of \$750 for a service project for placing second in the category of most actual funds raised for the Foundation. Muncie IN placed first (with a much larger membership) in this category. They placed second in the category 'per capita' giving. Congratulations to our club members for their personal donations and for the club's annual donations to the Grants Fund and Club 21.

Elaine and Dana will also have reports on everything that happened at Convention. See page 3 for a photo of the newly installed International Board of Directors. In the upcoming biennium, Elaine will be serving on the International BRR Committee. She is also chair of the District Six audit committee, which reviews all the expenditures and incomes of the District for the prior year. We are proud that our District remains so vigilant about maintaining open financial reporting.

As you may remember, our International organization got caught with two staff members embezzling funds from the International organization (not the Foundation). Following legal proceedings and claims with their insurance, they were able to recoup all the lost money except the \$1,000.00 deductible amount. Changes have been put in place in their accounting software and procedures to prevent another occurrence of this sort. Also an audit will be done this year to verify the fraud and recovery of the funds.

As always, the meeting begins at 7:00 p.m., but come between 6 and 6:30 to order from the menu and share a meal with your fellow Altrusans. Remember that if you have a standing reservation you only have to contact hospitality if you will not attend. The International Foundation also elected new trustees. Our own Dana Vierck retires as a trustee now. We met our new International Foundation Director Dr. Kantrice Rose. Our incoming Foundation Chair is Karen Robinson of the Tampa FL club. Ann Condran of the Muncie club is a new trustee on the Foundation Board.

Fox Valley was honored for raising the second most money for the International Foundation. And as first place for raising the most per capita (most \$ for a small club). Muncie placed 1st with most \$ and 2nd with most per capita. We were also honored as a Distinguished Club for 2021-22 & 2022-23.

In all there were 126 clubs registered with 14 districts represented. Dana & I were 2 of the 60 Past Governors present. District Six actually had 7 of our past governors in attendance.
